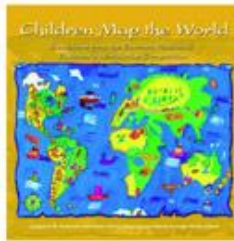

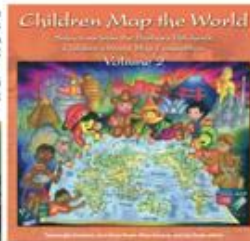


A nemzetközi térképrajz-verseny sikere feleltetett az ESRI vezetőség érdeklődéséért, és 2004-ben az ESRI Press szerződést kötött az ICA-val egy könyvsorozat megjelentetésére. 2005-ben az ESRI Press kiadta a „Children Map the World” sorozat első, 100 kiválasztott térképrajzot tartalmazó kötetét. A válogatás a verseny első 10 évében, 1993 és 2003 között benyújtott térképrajzokból történt. A könyvet hivatalosan az ESRI 2005-ös Felhasználói Konferenciáján mutatták be, San Diegóban.

Négy évvel később, 2009 novemberében került bemutatásra a második kötet, az ICA 24. Nemzetközi Térképészeti Konferencián Santiago de Chileben, és a 2005-ben és 2007-ben megszervezett két versenyből került ki a 100 válogatott térképrajz.

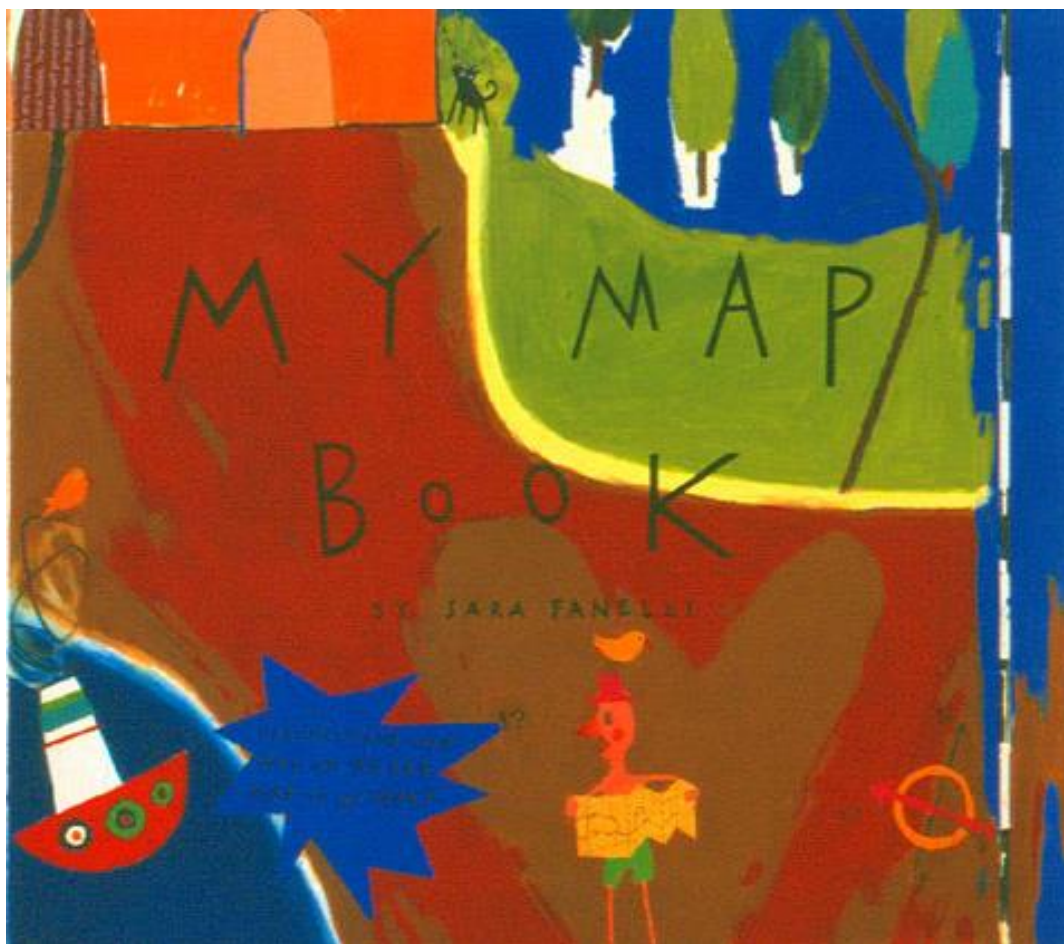
