ICA members from Austria and Poland wanted to know if there is a possibility for prolongation deadline for receiving children maps to the Netherlands. Officially it is difficult to be done because all important dates are announced in all materials for Chile conference, all announcements were sent to National Representatives, etc. But none officially the Dutch colleagues will accept all pictures coming with 1 to 2 weeks later and they will be included in CD which will be sent to Judging committee.

The **ESRI second book about** 100 favourite drawings "MANY NATIONS – ONE WORLD" chosen by BPC 2005 and 2007, ICA children map competition **CHILDREN MAP THE WORLD "MANY NATIONS – ONE WORLD" - Selection from the Barbara Petchenik Children's World map Competition** have been presented to commission members. Only 3 countries are not presented in the book.



In the time of the Seminar an exhibition on Czech national competition for Barbara Petchenik Competition was organized by the collaboration of Vit Vozenilek. It was great interest to the exhibition and it was also good propagation for all participants coming from 35 countries.

The new competition on Educational Cartography will be organized by ICA after the proposal of Patrick Wiegand, past

chairman of CCC. David Fraser, chairman of Commission on Education and Training proposed the organization of this new competition to be done by CCC and CET. Ferjan Ormeling proposed the rules of the competition to be written and discussed during the 24<sup>th</sup> ICC, Chile, November, 2009.

This is a research with students in different age groups in Austria, Bulgaria, Czech Republic and Slovakia. There is an interest similar experiment to be continued with Hungarian and Indonesian students.

About the Commission plans for the immediate future, during this year we would like to begin the contacts with colleagues to publish a book (a collection of studies) on Educational Cartography. Commission Co-Chairs were contacted by Ferjan Ormeling (ICA Publications Committee) and he was asked to add this publication to the future plans.
