

## 4. HISTORY OF NAME USE

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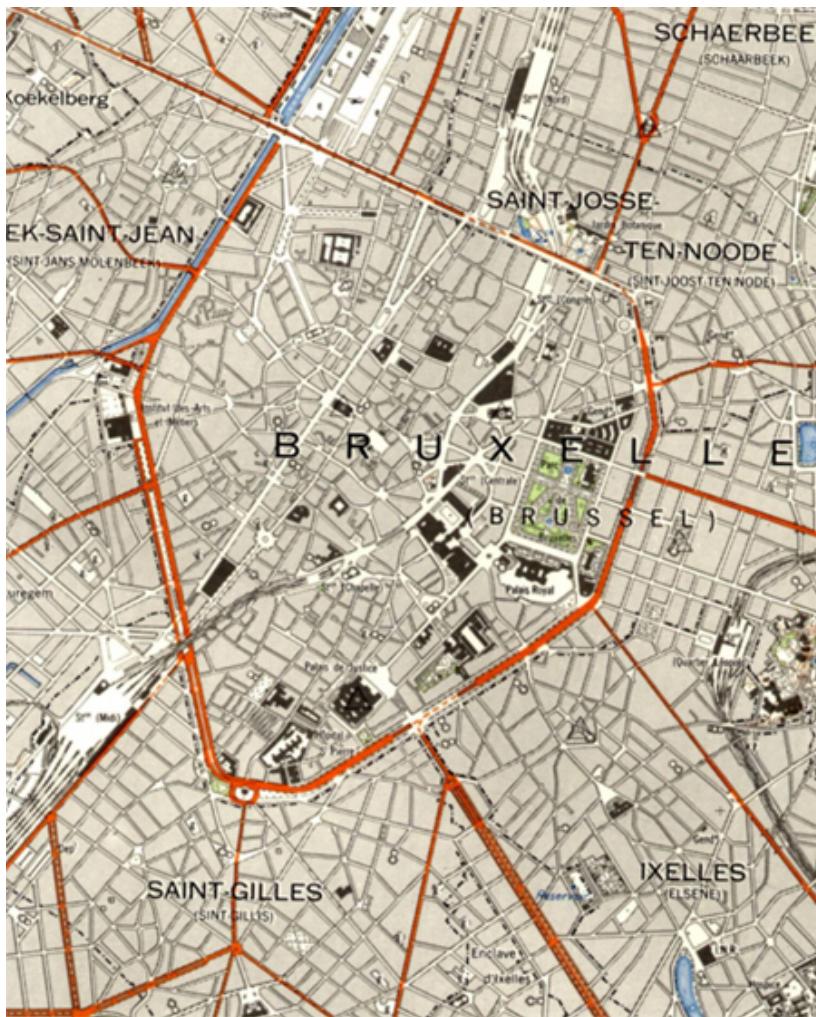
### Belgium:

**1898** Law equal rights language communities

**1930** Language act: Dutch names to be used in Dutch-speaking part

**1937** Names of Flanders municipalities defined (in Dutch)

**1950** First maps with Dutch names added (in parentheses)

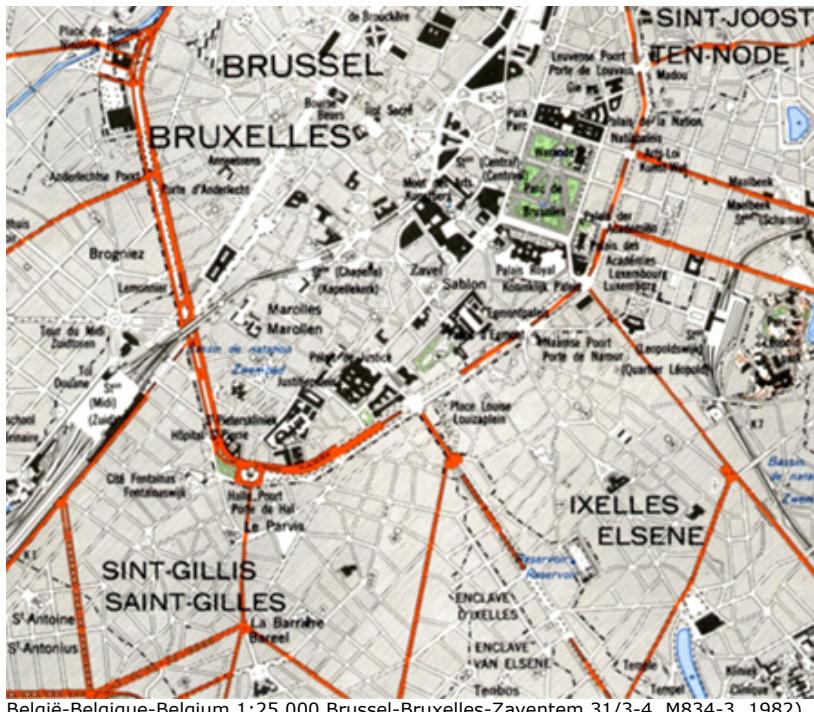


Belgique/België 1:25 000. Bruxelles-Zaventem. M834-1, 31/3-4 1959

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**1960** Second version: all names doubled > only space enough for half the names
