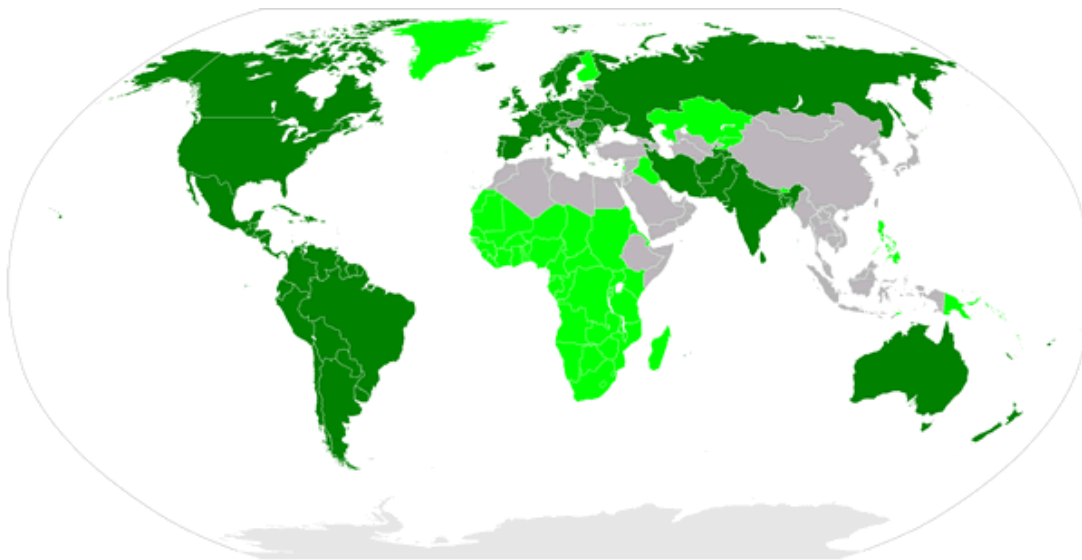


9. CLASSIFICATION OF LANGUAGES - E) THE INDO-EUROPEAN FAMILY

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- Spread since the 3rd Millennium B.C. all over Europe and well into S.W. and S.-Asia.
- Branches:
 - Italic (Latin and Romance languages)
 - Celtic (Gaelic, Welsh, Breton)
 - Germanic (German, English, Dutch, ...)
 - Baltic (Lithuanian, Latvian)
 - Slavic (Russian, Polish, Czech, ...)
 - Hellenic (Greek)
 - Indo-Iranian (Indian and Iranian languages)
 - Armenian
 - Albanian



- Countries with a majority of speakers of IE languages
- Countries with an IE minority language with official status
