

## 9. CLASSIFICATION OF LANGUAGES - E) THE INDO-EUROPEAN FAMILY


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- Spread since the 3rd Millennium B.C. all over Europe and well into S.W. and S.-Asia.

- Hellenic (Greek)
- Indo-Iranian (Indian and Iranian languages)
- Armenian
- Albanian
