To show all cells that have a specified attribute in a grid theme

From the table

- 1 Click on an integer grid theme to make it active, then press the Open Theme Table button.
- 2 Click the Select tool
- 3 Click on a cell value record in the table. This will highlight the record in the table. Cells that contain the selected value will also be highlighted in the view. To select more that one cell value at a time, hold down the shift key on the keyboard while clicking on several cell values in the table.

From the Query Builder

- 1 Click on a integer grid theme to make it active.
- 2 Press the Query Builder button
- 3 Formulate your query with the Query Builder. Cells with the selected values will also be highlighted in the view.

Selected cells and records will be highlighted in the selection color for the project. You can change this color in the Project Properties dialog, which comes up when you choose Properties in the Project menu.

Unlike feature themes, where you can select features from the view or table, grid themes can only have cell values selected from the table. Since many cells may be referenced by the same value in the table, selecting cells from the view is not possible.
