

Modifying a 3D perspective through zoom

You have several buttons to control zooming, both in the ArcView application window and the viewers. Zoom buttons on the ArcView application window control all viewers of that scene. Zoom buttons on a viewer control only that viewer.



Zoom to Full Extent - sets the scene to show all features for all themes. The target is in the center of all of the data with the observer outside, in the southwest.



Zoom to Theme - sets the scene to show all features for all active themes. The target is in the center of the data with the observer outside, in the southwest.



Zoom to Selected - sets the scene to show all selected features for all active themes. The target is in the center of the data with the observer outside, in the southwest.



Zoom In - brings the target closer, reducing the camera viewfield five degrees.



Zoom Out - moves the target away, increasing the viewfield five degrees. If you use this button many times, the field of view may become distorted, like looking through a fish-eye lens.
