Identifying and selecting features

You can identify and select features in 2D (planimetrically) or 3D (in perspective). Identifying and selecting features in a 3D scene has advantages over doing it in a view. In 3D, it's easy to notice the ridgeline with the great view and then identify the road that runs along it. You instantly know what road to travel for a nice afternoon walk or drive. In 2D, you may not have even notice the ridge or the view.
