The US DMA DTED raster file format

A United States Defense Mapping Agency Digital Terrain Elevation Data file is a raster data set representing the surface of the earth.

Only DTED data distributed on CD-ROM is supported. All DTED Level II data is distributed on 9-track tape and isn't supported.

Don't use DTED data that has horizontal units in decimal seconds with slope, hillshade, visibility, and curvature. Project it into a planar coordinate system with a package such as ARC/INFO before using any of the above functions.

The US DMA DTED raster file format can only be imported using the Spatial or 3D Analysts.
