On 4th October 2010 a red-mud accident happened at a sludge reservoir of alumina factory in Ajka (Hungary). The sludge with an alkaline value of pH 13 broke through the dam of the reservoir and flooded some 800 hectares of agricultural land and 3.5 hectares of built-up area of the settlements of Devecser and Kolontár. The disaster claimed 10 lives and caused immense material losses to human settlements, agriculture and ecology. The Hungarian Institute of Geodesy, Cartography and Remote Sensing (FÖMI) carried out a quick data analysis within 5 days of the accident in response to a decision of the Hungarian government, based on WorldView high resolution satellite images. The album reflects the various activities of data analysis.
