- This is the main idea of **Swiss Orienteering**.
- **Official start**: 2002, but real start 23rd May 2003 with the Guinness world record!

•2003: Guinness World Record and sCOOL Tour de Suisse stages

- •2014: all 3 parts are still active





Guinness World Record 2003

23rd May 2003 in Switzerland there were...:

- 11'992 participants in Ticino (Italian speaking area) and
- 200'547 participants in Switzerland
- ... who participated at least at one orienteering competition that day.

Record recognized! Registered as a Guinness record !









sCOOL Cup



 Competition for schools: every year we have a one day competition in spring or autumn, each canton/region organizes his own. Guests are members of the Swiss junior or élite national teams.

- Half a day in a school, 45-55 kids each time
- Goal of the day is to show how a real orienteering course works, offering also a competition with "quali" and "final".
- We also want to show that orienteering isn't something magic, it's easy you have fun even if you run around your school.





Tour de Suisse



Every year there are 150-170 stages all over Switzerland, that means 10'000-11'000 kids run one orienteering course.


The coach works 5 or 8 half days with the students. So it's possible to run quite more difficult competitions around the schools.

It's important to work with the "main" teacher. Textbook: It's sCOOL.


























What do we need?
