- Cartographic designs, applications and evaluations: new map interfaces, representations and map interaction designs for mobile platforms, map applications that are context-aware, personalized, adaptive and/or responsive across devices.
- Cognitive studies: new cognitive aspects of mobile map use, influence of dynamic environments, user behavior analysis (e.g., gaze behavior, spatial behavior), individual and group differences, information communication among the cartographic visualizations, the user and the environment.
