
Smartphone map app use Study

Criteria: For this research project we seek participants between 18 and 85 years old, who understand English, and own an Android Smartphone with a built-in GPS sensor.

Compensation: Participants will receive a voucher for the Google Playstore with a value of CHF 20.-

Participation: To participate in this study you will first need to register with a valid Email address with the QR code below, where you will also find further information. We also ask you to download and install a free app from the Google Playstore and use it on your own smartphone as usual for a period of two weeks. This app runs unnoticeably in the background. It continuously records all taps on the smartphone and your movement trajectories. The app does not record any personal data (e.g., text content, voice, pictures, etc.)
