Classes, entry regulations

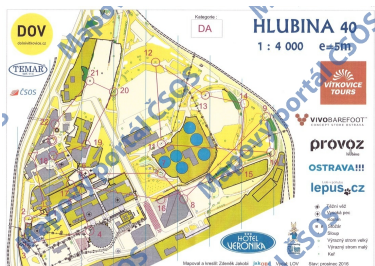
W/M 16 – girls and boys born 2003 or later
W/M 18 – girls and boys born 2001 or later
Each National team may participate with a maximum of 6 competitors per class. Additional competitors may participate in the accompanying Moravia championship.
All National teams – irrespective whether they come from the Central European sub-region or not – will be included in the Nation's Cup rankings.

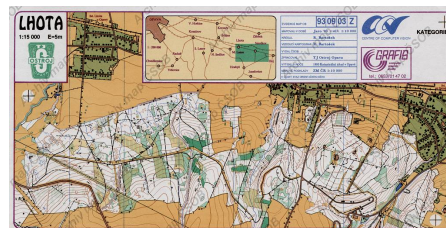
Hlubina 40 (2016)



Ostrá hůrka (1994)

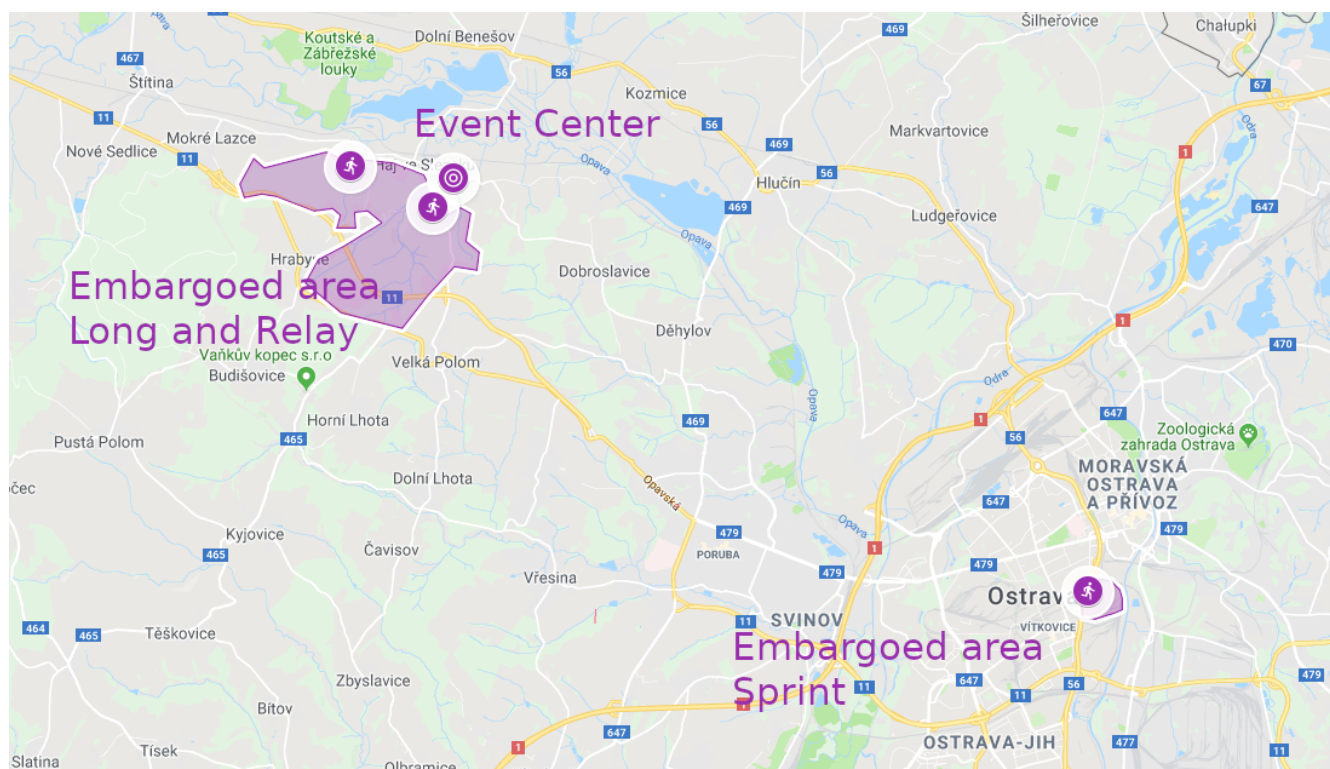


Lhota (1993)

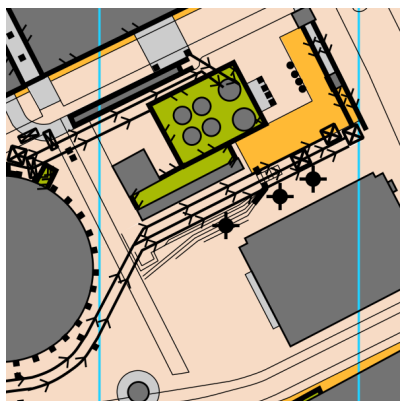

Sprint, Friday 5 April 2019



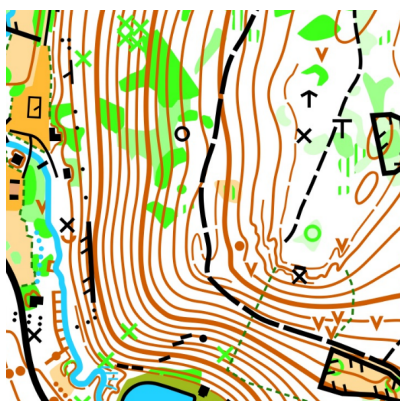

Terrain description: The Lower Vítkovice area (DOV) is revitalized former ironworks and coal mining complex in the heart of Ostrava city centre. It preserves state of ironworks from 60s and serves as museum, as an iq park and entertaining complex. Flat terrain with lots of paved areas.

Long, Saturday 6 April 2019



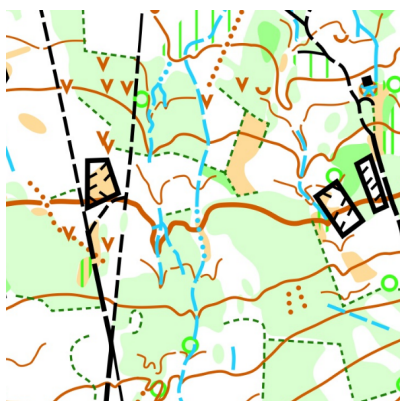

Terrain description: Moderately steep terrain with predominantly good runability. There are terrain remnants of World War II battles, pits and trenches including ruins of fortified defensive lines, deep valleys. Vegetation is half deciduous, half conifer. The greater part of the map is of good runability and visibility. There are some roads and paths of all categories.

Terrain description: Mostly the same character as for long distance. The difference makes smaller elevation, the presence of areas with seasonal water channels, and more detailed boundary between different vegetation types.
