VENUE



Chepelare is the principal town in Chepelare Municipality, part of Smolyan Province in Southern Bulgaria. It is situated in the central part of the Rhodopes, on the banks of Chepelare River. It is located near Pamporovo, one of the biggest Bulgarian ski resorts.

The town is known for the only ski and snowboard factory in the Balkan Peninsula. The factory cooperates with the ski brand Atomic Skis. Chepelare is also the

birthplace of biathlete Ekaterina Dafovska, Bulgaria's only Winter Olympics gold medal winner. The local Sports School provides good conditions for young winter athletes. Chepelare is located 70 km from Plovdiv and 210 km from Sofia.

During the competitions, the event office moves out to the competition arena.

CLASSES AND PARTICIPATION RESTRICTIONS

• <u>ESOC/WORLD CUP (M/W 21):</u>

- Individual competitions: a federation may enter up to 6 men and 6 women. In addition to the number of participants entered for the Men/Women (6+6) every federation may enter up to two U23 women and two U23 men

- Relay: max 2 male teams and 2 female teams, each consisting of 3 competitors.

- Sprint relay: max 3 teams, each consisting of 2 competitors.

If a federation is represented by two or more teams in a relay class, only the best-placed team will count in the results list.

The current European champion of the distance shall be given a wild card for the red group in addition to the ordinary entries from his/her federation.

• <u>U23 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS</u>

U23 competitors are Elite athletes who are up to and including 23 years old. They compete in Women/Men and shall be ranked in both the U23 World Cup and the Elite World Cup as well as the U23 World Championships and the ESOC.

In addition to the number of participants entered for the Men/Women (6+6) every federation may enter up to two U23 women and two U23 men.

• <u>WMSOC: (M/W 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, M90)</u>

Open for everybody and the class depends on the age.

- Long distance: Single race event with random start order.
- Middle distance: Single race event with random start order.
- **Sprint distance:** Single race event with random start order.

Medals are awarded in long distance, middle distance, and sprint distance events (three sets of medals).

FINAL ENTRIES

Final entries giving the names of participants must be made through IOF Eventor. The entry deadlines according to the event programme shall be followed!

NUMBER BIBS and NUMBER VESTS

Number vests will be used for ESOC and WMSOC. The number vests will be handed out on the day before competition in the event office.

GPS-TRACKING and TV-STREAMING

There will be no live broadcast or open GPS tracking until the races are over in the individual starts.

50 men and 30 women will be selected for GPS tracking. Selected runners will be indicated in the start lists. GPS devices will be distributed in the pre-start area and have to be worn in a special pocket inside the number vest. GPS devices will be collected after the finish of each competition.

Live services of the event include live results, live camera feed and speaker sound from the arena.

ACCOMMODATION and MEALS

• When staying in hotels, the rules for indoor spaces must be followed. It is mandatory to wear a mask in all indoor public places in BULGARIA (incl. shops).

• Accommodations and meals will be organized to minimize contact between different teams. Strictly follow the schedule for meals service per team!

• Follow all venue and organizer instructions! It is recommended that athletes not visit grocery shops, pharmacy and other external shops and establishments (restaurants, cafés etc)

• Team leaders may visit grocery and pharmacies on behalf of the team. Note: the number of team leaders with external contact should be limited and they should have limited contact with athletes.

• Access to the Borika Hotel will be restricted for accommodated competitors and hotel staff. The staff has been instructed to observe safety precautions and are required to be vaccinated. The hotel will accommodate 6 teams - Finland, Russia, Sweden, Norway, Switzerland, and Latvia. Meals will be scheduled by the organizers to avoid crowding. No other guests at the hotel! These measures will also apply to other hotels proposed by the organizers!

TRANSPORT

The organizers have decided to cancel the transportation of competitors with the transport of the organizers. All teams must rent cars or buses on their own. Our official transport partner company is <u>TOP RENT-A-CAR</u>.



PUNCHING and TIMING SYSTEM

SPORTident AIR+ contactless punching is used as electronic punching and timing system.

Every competitor will have two SIACs. Both SIACs must be carried on the same arm (wrist or finger).

Upon accreditation, each athlete receives one personalized SIACs from the organizer free of charge. The organizers will provide the second Si-card for all competitors who need – 10 EUR rent for the whole championships. The other SIACs shall be used by the athlete for all competitions.

To avoid interference, any GPS-watches must not be worn on the same arm!

All SIACs given by the organizers must be returned by team-leaders after the last competition. If a SIAC is lost or not returned, a fee of 65 Euro per SIAC is charged.

One SIAC is marked as "backup" with a a black stripe around the red SIAC body. The "backup" SIAC is silent (no beep) and flashes only once at each control. This makes

concentrating on the "primary" SIAC easy. By default, only the "primary" SIAC (no black stripe or body) is downloaded after finishing the race. The "backup" SIAC is downloaded in exceptional cases at the organizer's decision only.

In the model event, the control setup used for all competitions is demonstrated.

The punching procedure is as follows: initially, the SIAC (SPORTident Active Card) is inactive. Before the start, first the "CLEAR" and then the "CHECK" station must be punched "in hole". After that, the SIAC is in active = contactless mode. Athletes can confirm this by swiping past a provided "TEST" station. The SIAC (not the station!) beeps and flashes for a few seconds. If a SIAC fails to confirm the contactless punch at any control, a traditional "in hole" punch can always be made. Additionally, each control has two SI-stations (one on each side of the track).

At the finish, the time is taken when crossing the finish-line at full speed, no station needs to be punched.

Notice: crossing the finish line during the competition prematurely deactivates the SIAC! Pay attention which lane to take, especially at mass-start/looped courses!

EMBARGOED AREA

You can see a **<u>detailed map</u>** of the embargoed area. It is strictly forbidden to enter embargoed area. Accommodation inside the embargoed area is also forbidden.

The terrain used for Bulgarian national championships is not embargoed now and can be used for trainings.

The extent of the embargoed area has been reduced. An updated map of the embargoed area is available on the link:

TERRAIN, MAPS and SNOW CONDITIONS

The terrain is moderately hilly to hilly, situated between 1500m and 1800m above sea level with spruce forests and open fields.

The average snow depth in the event terrain on 20st January is 20-50 cm.

Maps will be according to the International Specification for Ski Orienteering Maps 2019. Mapper – Georgi Hadzhimitev

All maps are A4 size $(21 \times 30 \text{ cm})$ with a 5 m contours interval.

The Model event will provide relevant examples of mapping, printing, terrain, control situation, punching system, start and finish procedure. It is strongly recommended for all participants of ESOC/ WCUP and WMSOC to attend the model event on 21st and 22nd January. It is allowed to visit model event area for trainings also at other times.

PARKING

Parking is available at the arena. Parking price -30 EUR for the whole championships or 10 EUR per day.

Please follow the signs and instructions of the parking marshals. The distance from the parking to the competition arena is maximum 200m. Please follow the signs and instructions from the parking marshals to avoid slowing the flow of traffic.

QUARANTINE AREA

All competitions in the program will be held (organized) without quarantine to avoid crowding.

START

In sprint and middle-distance competitions (interval start), there is a 4 minute pre-start. A start gate will not be used. The athletes receive the map 15 seconds before start. The start signal is given by sound from start clock. It starts beeping 3 seconds before actual start time and beeps 4 times – the competitor is allowed to start on last beep. There is an organizer keeping a hand on competitor's shoulder until the start moment.

In relays and long-distance competition, there are mass starts with assembly beginning 10 minutes before start. Athletes are called to the start area latest 5 minutes prior to the start time. CLEAR and CHECK of SIAC occurs at check-in to the start area. Maps are handed to the athletes between 90 and 45 seconds before the start. Athletes have to keep the map in their hand behind their back until the command "MAP" is given 15 seconds before the start. The start signal is given by a single gunshot. For the first approximately 50 meters, only double poling is allowed.

Competitors must follow the marked route from the time start to the map start triangle.

FINISH

There is a marked route from the last control to the finish, which must be followed by finishing competitors. The competition ends for a competitor when he/she crosses the finish line. After crossing the finish line or completing a changeover, the competitor shall download the data from the SIAC chip. Competitors wearing GPS device must hand over their devices to the organizers after the finish. The map must be given to the organizers immediately after the finish or changeover unless otherwise stated by the organizers.

TOILETS

Toilets are available at the arena and in Event office building.

RESULTS

Provisional results will be announced and displayed at the finish area as well as online at <u>www.liveorienteering.com</u> and <u>https://esoc-wmsoc2022.bg/</u> during the competition.

The official results will be published no more than 4 hours after the latest allowable finishing time of the last starter.

MAXIMUM RACING TIME

Every race has maximum skiing time:

- Sprint, 90 minutes for women and men
- Middle and Long distance, 3 hours for women and men
- Relay, 5 hours for women and men.
- Sprint Relay, 3 hours.

If the stated limit time is exceeded, the competitor / team will be disqualified.

ABANDONING A RACE

Athletes who wish/need to retire from a race must report to the finish as soon as possible and hand over to the finish staff their competition maps.

COMPLAINTS

Complaints may only be made by accredited team officials or competitors. Complaints should be handed in writing to the organizer at the event office as soon as possible after the incident in question or at the latest within 15 minutes of the publication of the full preliminary result for the class. Complaints received after this time limit will only be considered, if there are valid exceptional circumstances, which must be explained in the complaint. A complaint is adjudicated by the organizer. The complainant will be informed about the decision immediately.

Any protest against the complaint decision shall be presented in writing to the jury no later than 15 minutes after the organizer has informed the complainant of the decision about the complaint. A protest fee of 50 EUR or 98 BGN must be paid to the IOF Senior Event Adviser in cash when making a protest. The fee will be returned if the protest is accepted by the jury. When a protest is signed by more than one Federation, each Federation will pay the protest fee.

CEREMONIES

There will be no opening and closing ceremony.

Flower ceremonies will take place at the arena immediately after the races. The athletes/relay teams in 1st-3rd place will receive flowers.

The award ceremonies will be for competitors only and accredited officials and representatives, in outdoor location that ensures compliance with anti-epidemiological measures.

Prize-giving ceremonies will be held according to the event schedule outdoors at Borika hotel. The athletes/relay teams in 1st-6th place will receive awards.

WAXING FACILITIES AND SKI TESTING

In connection with the latest rules regarding fluor ban aligned with the International Federation (IOF), upon arrival of the teams all skis will be transported to a special place, which will be simultaneously waxing hall and ski storage space with security and access only for persons authorized by the teams.

Organizers provide a big waxing hall in the Sports School of Chepelare near to Event center (500 m). It is free of charge.

Waxing facilities are not available at the competition arena.

EQUIPMENT CHANGE AREAS

There will be a place for equipment change at arena passing. Team officials themselves can deposit equipment there for all distances that cross the arena. Exact information about equipment is under each day and will be given at team officials' meetings. Undamaged skichange is not allowed in any of the distances. In case of very dirty snow before pursuit/long distance competition, the team officials may agree that undamaged ski change is allowed on that distance.

ANTI DOPING

Doping is strictly forbidden, and the organizers of ESOC/WMSOC 2022 are dedicated to supporting the anti-doping authorities in their work. Doping controls may be carried out any time during the competition period. Selected athletes will be given instruction to report to the doping control after finishing their race, and will be escorted by a chaperone. Random doping control may occur even during the days when there are no competitions. Doping tests will always be carried out in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard for Testing and Investigations. The World Anti-Doping Code and IOF Anti-Doping Rules apply as of 1st of January 2021. Athletes selected for the doping tests must bring an official identification document (with photo) to the doping test area. Therefore, it is required that all the athletes have an ID document with photo with them at the competition centre. The athlete shall also bring their Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if applicable.

BANQUET

The banquet is cancelled.

HEALTH SERVICE

The organizers will co-ordinate health care services for the participants, but each federation is responsible for insurance for all their team members. Health-care services will be provided at the arenas of the competitions. The phone number for emergency calls is 112.

ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS – COVID-19

All participants must enter Bulgaria following the Bulgarian Health Ministry requirements based on the color code of the country they are entering from.

Once participants are in Chepelare, they need to report to the competition center/Hotel Borika first. Every participant will be tested with the PCR test. Results will be ready at the evening for the people tested during the day, and at the morning for the people tested the previous evening. While waiting for the results, competitors must be isolated in their accommodation. If the PCR test is positive, the person will be quarantined as per the COVID bulletin.

On the 25th of January, an antigen test will be taken as a precautionary measure. If the antigen test is positive, the person will be tested with a PCR test. If positive as well, isolation will take place as per Covid Bulletin.

Results will be sent via email.

We can also provide PCR/Antigen tests before departure. Please inform us when you come for the first test!

All costs for the test will be covered by the competitors/teams. PCR test costs 55eur. Antigen test costs 25eur.

11.01.2022 - the Minister of Health of Bulgaria issued a new order in which the 14-day period of isolation is changed to 10, and 10 days for contact persons is changed to 7 days. The director of the relevant regional health inspectorate may revoke the issued quarantine prescription for close contact person with an additional (booster) dose of COVID-19 vaccine by submitting a document via email showing a negative PCR result from a test conducted 72 hours after quarantine. The prescription is canceled within 24 hours from the presentation of the document showing a negative test result.
